Year 7 Induction Day – Wednesday 1st July 2026

Students: 9:15am – 3:00pm

Parents/guardians: 2:00pm – 3:00pm

We are very much looking forward to inviting your son/daughter into school for a full day of activities later this term and seeing you in the afternoon for an information session. **Please send your child to the induction day in their primary school uniform.**

Your child is invited into school for the day where they will meet other students in their Form, have a chance to meet their new Form Teacher and take part in several taster lessons. All children will be provided a free lunch in our school Hall; if your child would prefer, they can bring a packed lunch. If you are able, please send your child with a snack and a drink (preferably in a refillable water bottle) for breaktime.

Parents will hear talks from the Head of Year 7, along with other members of the Senior Leadership Team and have the chance to look at uniform samples, before collecting their child at the end of the day. There are many students attending the Induction Day, and we ask that only parents/guardians attend with their child, as we are limited to seating in the Hall, it is not possible to cater for other family members.

Please note that there is no visitor parking available at the main Keswick School. When dropping children off in the morning, please try not to use Church Lane before 9:00am as both sides of the narrow lane are used by school buses, and it is busy. **Please bring your child up to school via the central path accessed from Church Lane and sign them in outside the Queen's Hall before leaving.**

For the afternoon session, we ask that parents use our parking facilities at the Crosthwaite Centre and along Church Lane and that you arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the session starts. We hope to be able to open one of our school fields for overflow parking (also located on Church Lane), but this will very much be weather dependent. If this is not possible, there are plenty of paid for parking within Keswick town centre. Please see attached pdf for more information on parking options. If you are a blue badge holder and require disabled parking, please contact school on 017687 72605.

The day finishes at 3:00pm to enable you to leave before the school buses arrive on Church Lane to collect students at the end of the school day. Both sides of the lane are used so parked cars cause congestion.
