## **Optional PE Uniform**

- \* Hooded sweatshirt black/maroon/green
- \* Tracksuit bottoms black
- \* Baselayer top/leggings black
- \* Showerproof jacket black/maroon/green
- \* Rugby shorts black
- \* Athletics vest maroon/black Leggings – black – no branding or design

Jewellery and make-up

- Jewellery is restricted to one pair of plain stud earrings for pierced ears and a wrist watch. No other jewellery, fashion belts, charity bands, tattoos, nose studs, acrylic nails and brightly coloured nail polish are allowed.
- Conspicuous make-up or a fake tan is not allowed at school.

## Outer garment

- This should be weatherproof and in a sensible style (a waterproof/anorak in a plain colour is recommended).
- Additional items of clothing are not allowed.

<u>Hair</u>

- For safety reasons hair must be tied back during certain activities e.g. PE, work in laboratories/workshops.
- Hair styles must not follow extremes of fashion (i.e. not grade 1 or 2), including colours or extensions.
- Boys must be clean-shaven for school.

#### Canteen payment card and lanyard

• This is school uniform and students must have the appropriate coloured lanyard and a canteen payment card with them every day.

#### School bag

• This is required to bring in books and equipment. Carrying books and equipment in a school blazer is not acceptable.
