Hot on the heels of National Apprenticeship Week, comes National Careers Week which started on Monday.

Careers is something that Keswick School takes very seriously <u>ALL</u> year round, from Year 7 to Year 13. However, we do dedicate some time this week to highlight its importance.

As Careers Lead in school I address every year group on a particular them or subject. Past assemblies have been about "Gender Stereotyping", "It's Not What You Know, "Joining the Dots", "Careers Resilience" and "Belief in Yourself".

This year it is entitled "<u>Un</u>employability Skills" and it has focussed on 3 that staff member, employers, and perhaps you as parents, find frustrating: <u>flakiness</u>, the <u>shoulder shrug</u>, and <u>burying one's head in the</u> <u>sand</u>.

Years 7 and 8 will take part in the Staff Careers Treasure Hunt, where they try to match the staff member to the careers story by asking them questions. With varied stories from (accidentally!) kicking the Prime Minister in the knee, to being held up by gunpoint in a bank; from working as a stop/go traffic sign, to being chauffeured to work by Dennis in a Daimler Jaguar, to being complimented by Dec (as in "Ant and Dec") for her tea-making skills; from being a giraffe keeper, to dressing up as a giant parrot; our staff have done very interesting things before coming to work at Keswick School.

In addition, Year 7, 8 and 9 have been talking to their Year 13 Form Prefects about their careers journey through school in their Futures Friday session today.
