## **Juice Academy Apprenticeships (Years 11 – 13)**

Juice Academy are a Manchester based not-for-profit that works in partnership with Apprentify to deliver the Level 3 Junior Content Producer apprenticeship. They currently have a number of employers around the country that are looking to take on an apprentice in September, and Juice are looking to bring on some suitable candidates to be considered for the roles. The training is delivered online by industry professionals from their sister company, Tangerine Communications.
