EAL Support

A dedicated mode provides glossaries and support for academic and subject-specific vocabulary, helping EAL pupils access the curriculum alongside their peers.

Dyslexia-Friendly

Pupils can enable a dyslexia-friendly reading overlay and switch the interface to a dyslexia-friendly font.

Text-to-Speech

Content can be read aloud, supporting pupils who benefit from audio reinforcement.

Speech-to-Text

Pupils can respond verbally rather than typing, removing barriers for pupils who find written input difficult.
