



<b>A LEVEL</b> AQA <a href="#">7201</a>	<b>ART, CRAFT &amp; DESIGN</b>
SPECIFIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS	Due to the skills required for Art A Level, it is essential that any student wishing to take the subject has taken Art at GCSE: a grade 5 is required.
COURSE CONTENT	<p>Students who will be suited to this course will be creative, Open-minded and inspiring, and will have an enthusiasm for the subject. They will need to have an awareness of their natural environment and an ability to analyse works of art.</p> <p><b>Component 1:</b> personal investigation (60%)  <b>Component 2:</b> externally set assignment (40%): 15 hours of supervised time plus preparatory period</p> <p>Year 12 consists of a series of workshops, to build upon and further develop existing artistic skills, in a variety of disciplines.</p> <p>Year 13 consists of one substantial project, concluding with the externally set assignment which will be distributed on 1st February.</p>
EXAMINATIONS AND ASSESSMENTS	The examination will be taken at the end of the two-year course in the spring term. Each component has a weighting towards the final grade.
SKILLS, LINKS AND PROGRESSION	<p>This course will enable students to progress to foundation art courses or gain direct entry onto degree courses in art, design, architecture and photography.</p> <p>Potential career areas from this subject include advertising, graphics, fashion, film and television, interior design, product design and stage design.</p> <p>Students in this subject need to have a high degree of self-motivation, independent thought, confidence in their own ability as artists and, most importantly, the will to succeed.</p>
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
