Enrichment and Extra-curricular Opportunities

The department runs a wide range of extra-curricular activities that all students are welcome to participate in, these include Keswick School bands, string ensembles, chamber music ensembles, vocal groups and various student rock and pop bands. There is also a music theory class.

The music department has a large, highly qualified and experienced number of specialist instrumental teachers who visit the school during the week to give tuition on an individual (sometimes paired or group) basis. Pupils have the opportunity to begin learning to play an instrument or to continue studying an instrument they already learn.

Violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, saxophone, French horn, trumpet, cornet, trombone, euphonium, tenor horn, tuba, piano, classical, acoustic, electric and bass guitar, ukulele, percussion/drum kit, voice, music production and music theory.

Pupils also regularly take part in local music festivals where they have regularly won prizes and the Rotary Young Musician of the Year where our students have also been very successful.

Annual performance opportunities include the Christmas Carol Service, Keswick Young Musicians Concert at the Theatre by the Lake, Spring Concert and Band night. The department also arranges performance opportunities including busking, music in assembly and informal concerts.
