In Key Stage 3 students study the following topics:

Year 7:

An introduction to history including chronology, bias, using source evidence, as well as the Legacy of the Roman Empire and the Norman conquest of England.

Year 8:

Changes in the power of the monarchy, religion and society in Britain 1485 to circa 1750, as well as the development of empires including the slave trade.

Year 9:

The developments in the 20th century including political developments, changes in national and civil rights, as well as social developments in Britain, Europe and the international.
